



*FREE TRAINING – HEALTH SERVICES ASSISTANCE

About the program

The Certificate III in Health Services Assistance provides the training required to commence a career in Health Services. This qualification provides the range of essential skills and knowledge for healthcare workers who provide support to the staff who care for clients/patients in various healthcare environments.

What the program involves

During this course you will learn about working in the nursing profession, provide support services related to client/patient care, such as client transport, cleaning, and food preparation /delivery. Students also gain knowledge regarding First Aid, Occupational Health and Safety, Infection Control, teamwork and communication skills.

Workers in some sections of this industry may be required to undergo a Police Check and Working with Children Check and apply for a Blue Card. For more information visit www.bluecard.qld.gov.au.

*Entry Requirements

- A job seeker (not currently working)
- Australian citizen or a permanent resident of Australia.
- #17 years of age or above.
- Not self-employed or a full-time student

Students must be competent in Literacy in order to fulfil course requirements. If you feel you have literacy needs that may impair your ability to work in this program please discuss this with an educator and an assessment interview can be arranged.

Students under 18 years of age must have parental/guardian approval.

Program Outcomes

Career options may include: Assistant in Nursing, Wardsperson, Patient Services Assistant, Orderly, and Allied Health Assistant.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning provides students an opportunity to have their current skills and competencies recognised. These skills and competencies may relate to units you are about to commence and as a result can exempt you from studying these units.

The process requires students to gather evidence confirming their competency. An educator will advise you when completing this task. **Enquire if you think you qualify.**
