CHC60208 Advanced Diploma of Children's Services – External

What does the course involve?

This self-directed course is designed to equip students with an advanced level of knowledge to operate programs for children, supervise staff members, provide specialist services and to work intensively with clients.

It is designed to develop leadership and management skills for those currently working in Children's Services and who hold positions of responsibility and wish to gain further qualifications to work more effectively in Children's Services.

To gain entry into this course, candidates must be recognised as competent against compulsory units in the CHC50908 Diploma of Children's Services (Early Childhood Education and Care).

How long does it take?

This course is delivered externally and can be studied from home or in the workplace and the duration is 52 weeks.

Students who have not completed their qualification in the stated timeframe can continue the program self-paced on a per unit basis at an additional cost.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning provides students an opportunity to have their current skills and competencies recognised. These skills and competencies may relate to units you are about to commence and as a result can exempt you from studying these units. However, there is a cost related to obtaining Recognition of Prior Learning.

The process requires students to gather evidence confirming their competency. An educator will advise you in this task.

Entry Requirements

The Diploma of Children's Services or equivalent, plus relevant and current industry experience.

Applicants will be given advanced standing from common Diploma competencies into this upgrade course.

What are my employment opportunities?

Leadership or management positions in the Children's Services Industry.

Family Day Care Coordinator, Director of a Child Care Centre or Outside School Hours Care Coordinator.

Field Placement

Field Placement forms an essential part of your competency-based assessment and provides you with practical components. There are two placements of up to 120 hours which the Educator will assist you in organising.

You are able to do this at your place of work if you are currently working in the Children's Services Industry.
