## CHC40108 Certificate IV in Aged Care

### What does the course involve?

This qualification is designed to equip students with the skills to work in Aged Care facilities, hostels, group homes and community settings. With a strong practical focus, you gain the skills required to perform personal care and activities of daily living to elderly individuals and people with a physical and/or psychological disability.

You will learn how to work with and provide services to people with complex needs, promote independence and community participation and supervise a small number of workers. Undertaking this course will provide career opportunities such as becoming a Care supervisor, Personal care worker, Accommodation support worker, or a Program support worker.

The qualification is made up of 15 units of competency:

### 11 Compulsory Units

- CHCAC412A** Provide services to older people with complex needs
- CHCAC416A** Facilitate support responsive to the specific nature of dementia
- CHCAC417A** Implement interventions with older people at risk of falls
- CHCAD401D** Advocate for clients
- CHCCS400A** Work within a relevant legal and ethical framework
- CHCICS401A** Facilitate support for personal care needs
- CHCICS402A** Facilitate individualised plans
- CHCINF403C** Co-ordinate information systems
- CHCNET404A** Facilitate links with other services
- CHCORG406A** Supervise work
- CHCOHS312A** Follow safety procedures for direct care work

### 4 Elective Units

- HLTHIR403B** Work effectively with culturally diverse clients and co-workers
- CHCINF408C** Comply with information required for aged care and community sectors
- CHCDIS301A** Work effectively with people with a disability
- CHCMH402A** Apply understanding of mental health issues and recovery processes

### How long does it take?

The course duration is 12 months with the delivery mode being external. Placement involves 120 hours if you are working in the aged care industry and 160 hours if you are not. Your educator will assist you in organising your placement.

### Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning provides students an opportunity to have their current skills and competencies recognised. These skills and competencies may relate to units you are about to commence and as a result can exempt you from studying these units. However, there is a cost related to obtaining Recognition of Prior Learning.

The process requires students to gather evidence confirming their competency. An educator will advise you in this task. Enquire if you think you qualify.

## Entry Requirements

Students must be competent in Literacy in order to fulfil course requirements. If you feel you have literacy needs that may impair your ability to work in this program please discuss this with an educator and an assessment interview can be arranged. Students younger than 18 years must have parental /guardian approval. Overseas students require language proficiency of IELTS level 5.5 or equivalent.

To gain entry into this course the candidate must be recognised as competent, against compulsory units from CHC30208 Certificate III in Aged Care or the equivalent.
