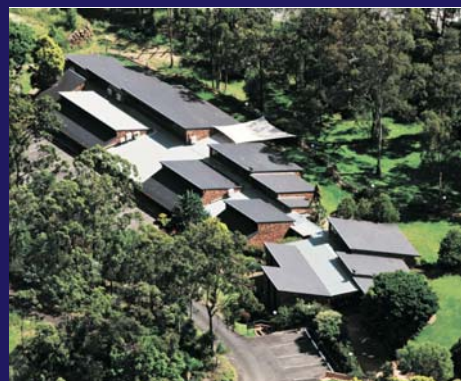

Welcome to King's International College English Language Centre

The Gold Coast is a wonderful place to learn English; the climate is great and there are many things to see and do. The i-Choose English program gives students the opportunity to make the most of their time in Australia while developing their English to the best of their abilities.

i-Choose English Program*

Students can start any Monday and may study 20 or 25 contact hours per week for as many weeks as they like.

Levels range from Elementary to Advanced with a focus on: reading, writing listening and speaking skills as well as test preparation, grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation etc.

*Note: Student Visa holders must study full-time on CRICOS registered courses

The i-Choose English program is designed to:

- develop students' confidence in using English in the skill areas of reading, writing, speaking and listening in order to communicate more effectively in English in both formal and informal settings.
- develop students' English proficiency so they can focus on IELTS, TOEFL or TOEIC Test preparation or English for Academic Purposes once they have attained the appropriate level of English
- develop students' English proficiency so they can enter one of King's vocational education programs

Student progress is assessed through weekly in-class tests and 5-weekly major assessment tasks.



Test Preparation (IELTS/TOEFL/TOEIC)

There are 2 elements which must be considered when planning to sit an English language test such as IELTS, TOEFL or TOEIC. Students must raise their English level and develop test-taking skills if they want to achieve their highest potential score. Our test preparation courses are run in conjunction with the i-Choose English program so that students improve their English language ability and also develop their test-taking skills. Assessment tasks, and grading and marking criteria for Test Preparation courses are based on the components of the actual tests.

Study Tours

King's International College also offers English language Study Tours. Our tours provide a great opportunity for students to improve their English language skills while enjoying all the exciting activities the Gold Coast has to offer. Study Tours generally range from 2 weeks to 1 month and include tuition, accommodation and excursions. All tours are specially designed for each group's specific needs.

Accommodation

King's International College can arrange homestay accommodation if required. The homestay service is a very popular way for students to live with an Australian family and experience the local lifestyle and culture while improving their English.

Our experienced Accommodation Officers will ensure, where possible, that students are matched with a family that suits their individual interests and needs. Airport pick up and drop off can be arranged. We can also assist students who want to rent their own accommodation.

Activities

Visitors to the Gold Coast have access to some of the best activities in the world. They can visit one of the many theme parks, swim and surf at Australia's premier surf beaches and explore the unique nature and wildlife Australia has to offer. The weather on the Gold Coast is fantastic with an average of 300 days of sunshine a year and maximum temperatures in the low to high twenties.

Resources

Students' learning is supported by the availability of traditional texts in the classroom. Teacher-generated and authentic materials such as newspapers, brochures, timetables, maps, menus, magazines, real estate booklets, videos and a myriad of resources on the Internet are used in class. This approach is based on sound language theory and current trends in successful second language acquisition. Internet, e-mail and computer access are included free of charge.

i-Choose English Program: Special Features

The i-Choose English program has 3 special features which make King's International College the ideal place to learn English;

- 1 The i-Choose English program is divided into 2 skill groups: 1) reading & writing; and 2) listening & speaking. On the first day at the English Language Centre, the students are tested in the 4 language skills and then placed in the appropriate classes for their skill group level. For example, a student may study at an intermediate level for reading & writing and a pre-intermediate level for listening & speaking. This allows the students to receive the most suitable level of tuition for their language abilities.
- 2 The Supplementary Skills classes are designed to suit the students' particular needs, including: IELTS, TOEFL & TOEIC test preparation; grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation activities etc.
- 3 The i-Choose English program also gives the students a choice of study times. Students can choose:
 - i-Choose English 1:** 20 hours per week (Monday to Friday, 8:30 to 1:00)
 - i-Choose English 2:** 20 hours per week (Monday to Thursday, 8:30 to 2:30)
 - i-Choose English 3:** 25 hours per week (Monday to Friday, 8:30 to 2:30)
