

# LIFEGROUPS - Facilitator Notes

## The V.I.P. of Prayer (Part 1)



### Suggested Icebreaker:

What is one thing you are praying and believing for at the moment?

## V = Vision of Prayer

Word: Mark 11: 20-23

Note: Mark 11: 13 & 14

**Q:** What was Jesus visualising when He spoke to the tree (v14)?

**A:** The result in v 20 & 21.

**Q:** Do you have a clear vision for what you are praying for?

\*\*\* Be specific and always pray the solution not the problem \*\*\*

**Remember:** "God calls those things which are not as if they are" Romans 4: 17

**Focus Point:** Vision allows you to focus your faith in prayer (v 23)

**Q:** Jesus describes the vision. What is it?

**A:** A mountain removed and cast into the sea

**Q:** What did Jesus say would ensure successful prayer?

**A:** Believing in the vision of prayer (v23)

**Q:** Can you think of other examples in scripture?

**A:** Matt 9: 20 – 22

The woman with an issue of blood - she knew what she wanted and believed she'd receive.

Matt 12: 10 – 13

The man with the withered hand - Jesus knew what He would do and did it.

**Q:** Have you got an example of a time when your vision for what you were praying for came to pass?

**Q:** Are you still waiting for an answer?

**Q:** What could help crystallise your vision even more?

### Suggestions:

- Maybe pray for/with those who are still praying through things.
- Ask God to give you a clearer vision.
- Might be good, if group members are willing, to delegate the cell (or at least some of the members) to stand and pray. Making prayer covenants with each other in other words.

**Remember:** Gideon had a vision to see God's confirmation to him of what he felt God wanted him to do!

**Q:** What was his vision?

**A:** A wet then a dry fleece.
